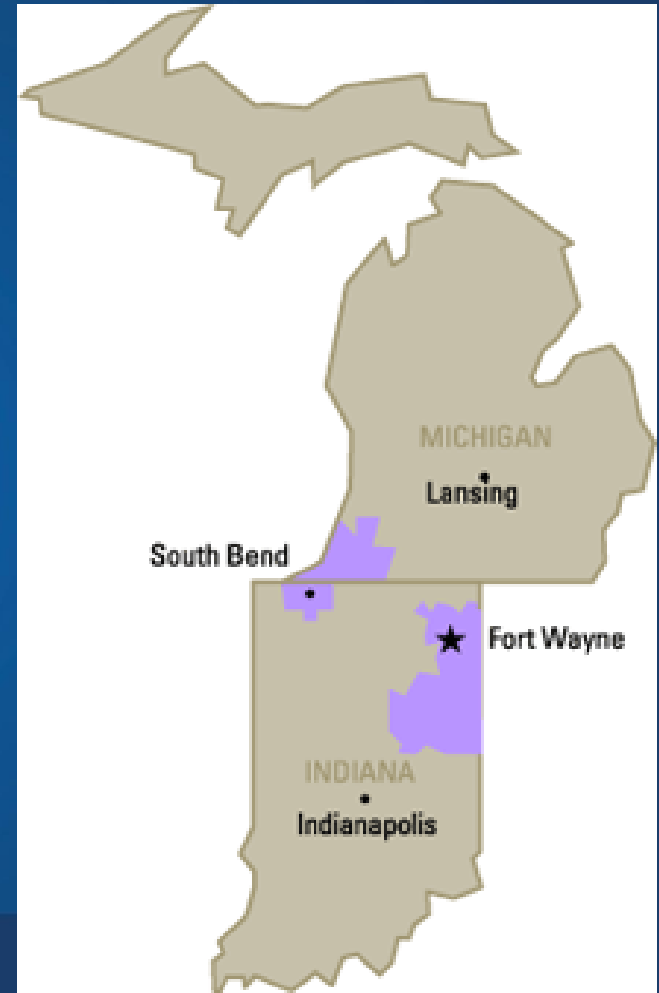

INDIANA MICHIGAN POWER

- 2,758 employees
- 583,000 customers
- 3,973 miles transmission lines
- 19,990 miles distribution lines
- Mix of low-cost generation
 - Coal: 3,595 MW
 - Nuclear: 2,160 MW
 - Hydro: 22 MW
 - Wind: 150 MW (late 2009)



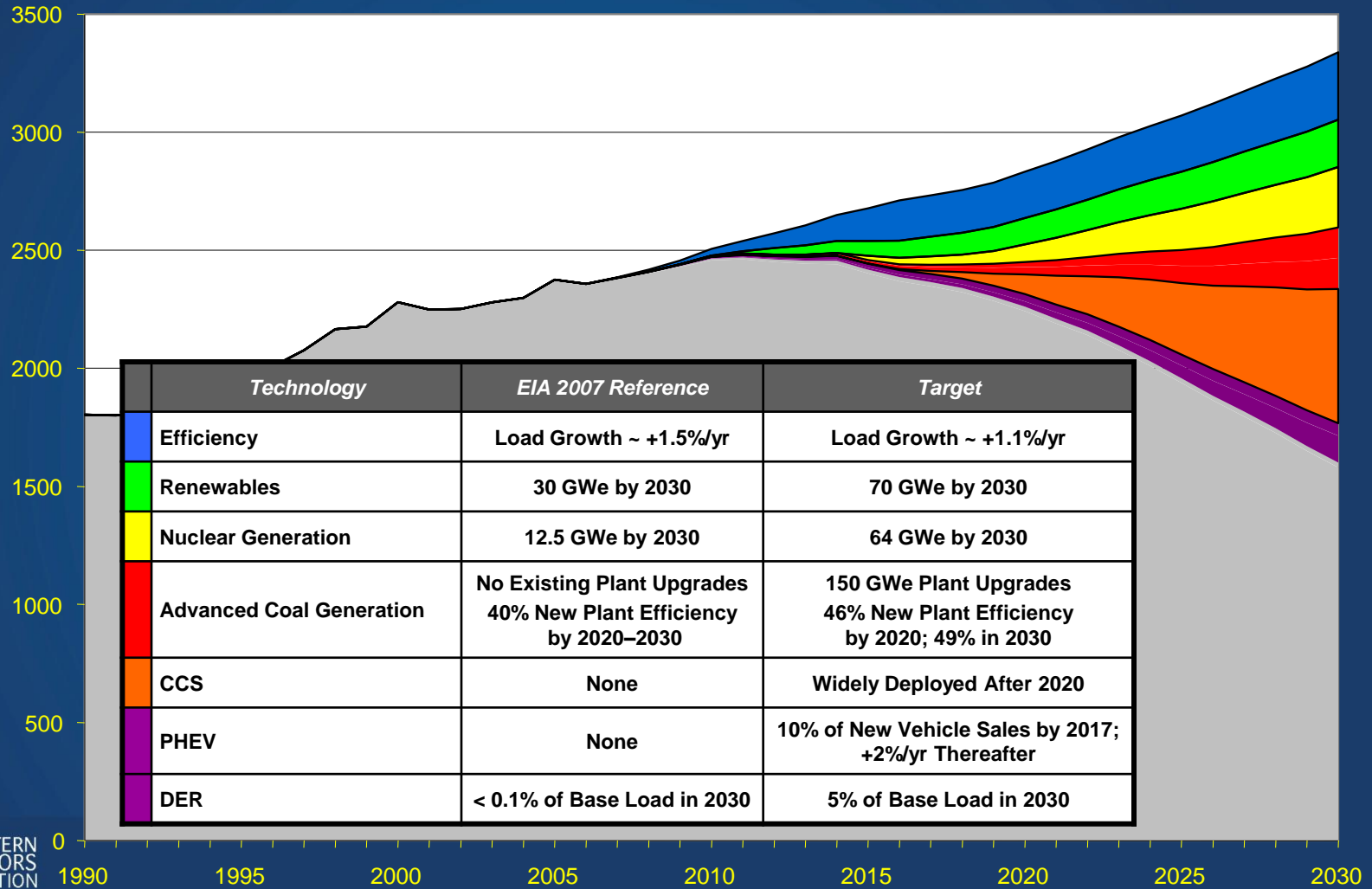
AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER

- 20,000 employees
- One of the largest generators of electricity, with 36,000 MW of generating capacity
- Generation sources: Coal, natural gas, nuclear, hydro, biomass and wind
- Largest owner of transmission lines in U.S.
 - Three grid areas: PJM, ERCOT and SPP
- Owns one of the largest barge and rail fleets in U.S.
- Seven regulated utilities operating in 11 states including Indiana Michigan Power

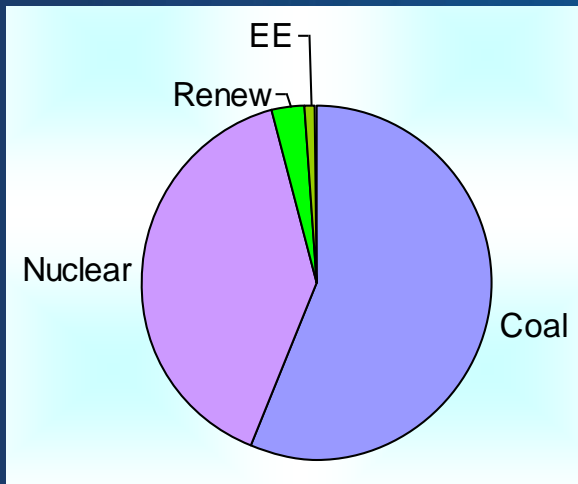


Prism: Electric Sector CO₂ Reduction Potential

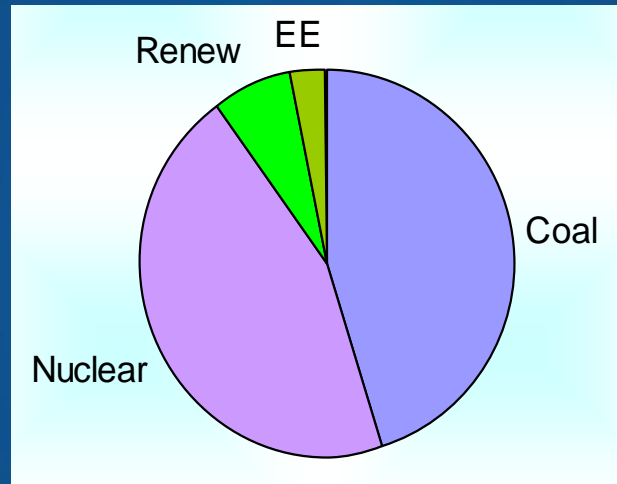
U.S. Electric Sector
CO₂ Emissions (million metric tons)



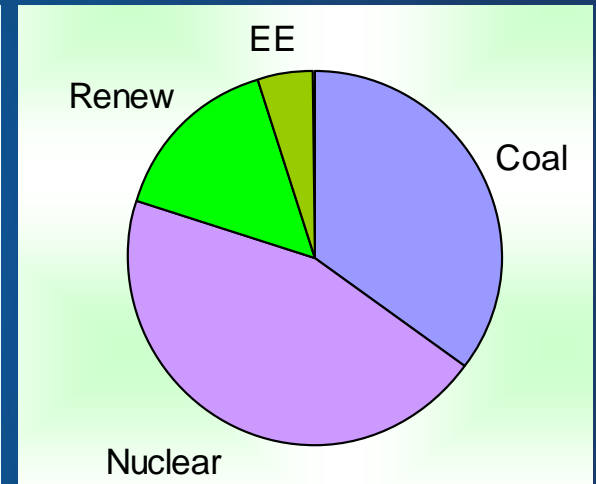
