- Fast Forward: <u>http://www.wisconsinfastforward.com/</u> In particular, the **Blueprint for Prosperity** initiative within Wisconsin Fast Forward includes two programs that target students (high school and college) with skill development and credential attainment:
  - **High School Pupil** program: \$4.6M awarded to applicants (e.g. high schools, technical colleges, workforce development boards, employers, etc.) to date who build skill development through employerdefined (demand driven) programs, including dual enrollment programming. Over 2,000 high school students will be participating in these programs. Some include certification testing with national accreditation agencies.
