

# The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law

## What is it?

> **375** unique programs at over a dozen federal agencies

> **125** new programs across 9 federal agencies representing  
>25% of total spending

---

> **90%** of these investments will be delivered by non-federal partners

~ **60%** flowing through formula programs

~ **38%** of funding contains provisions that allow for expanded federal cost sharing arrangements – particularly for rural and disadvantaged communities.

## What is it?

- **Build.gov/Rural**
- **Purpose** - Identifies programs and sources of funds set aside for rural communities under BIL
- **Cost Sharing Waivers and other Flexibilities** - 100 programs with cost share or matching requirement waivers and flexibilities
- **Agency Factsheets** - DOT, Commerce, EPA, DOI, Energy, USDA, FEMA
