Dear Senators Reid and McConnell, Speaker Pelosi, and Congressman Boehner:

We wanted to convey our appreciation and congratulations on last month's passage of the Food, Conservation and Energy Act, commonly referred to as the farm bill. This is a monumental piece of legislation and is a welcome solution to a long process.

The provisions in the farm bill are of great importance to the members of the Midwestern Governors Association (MGA), as the programs are directly related to the interests and livelihoods of our states. As you may recall, the MGA provided a publication outlining the policy objectives and recommendations the Midwestern governors had on the farm bill. We hope these were helpful and applicable to you as you wrote, debated and passed this important piece of legislation.
