Minnesota Governor Dayton Elected Chair of the MGA

Focuses Agenda on Coordinating State Response to Invasive Species

Washington, D.C. – Minnesota Governor Mark Dayton was elected Chair of the Midwestern Governors Association (MGA) today during its annual meeting in Washington, D.C. Governor Dayton is replacing Iowa Governor Terry Branstad, who served as Chair in 2012 during the MGA's 50th anniversary year.

Dayton's agenda for 2013 will focus on coordinating state responses to invasive species. While the Chair's agenda provides the opportunity to highlight all regional efforts to address both land and aquatic invasive species, the primary focus of the agenda will be Asian carp and zebra mussels.

To help carry out this initiative, Midwestern governors will work together to identify opportunities and barriers, and will create cross-state strategies to achieve these goals. The MGA also plans to hold a meeting of governors' policy advisors, state natural resources and agriculture secretaries, federal agencies, and experts from academia.

"I am honored to have been chosen by my fellow governors to be Chair of the Midwestern Governors Association. I look forward to working with them to further strengthen our region and address invasive species, which are a significant threat to our region's ecosystem, way of life and economic stability. I also want to thank Governor Branstad for his tremendous leadership and work to renew the Midwestern brand over the past year," said Dayton.

In addition to focusing on regional coordination efforts on invasive species, Dayton plans to continue the efforts initiated under Branstad's 2012 agenda to increase the production of low-cost energy by highlighting regional industrial energy efficiency opportunities, strategies for increasing alternative vehicle fueling stations and opportunities for better regional transmission.

Governors also heard from U.S. Department of Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack and Jerrod Roberts, winner of the MGA's video contest, *America's Smartland: Let the Midwest Surprise You!*

Dayton will serve as Chair of the MGA until February 2014.
