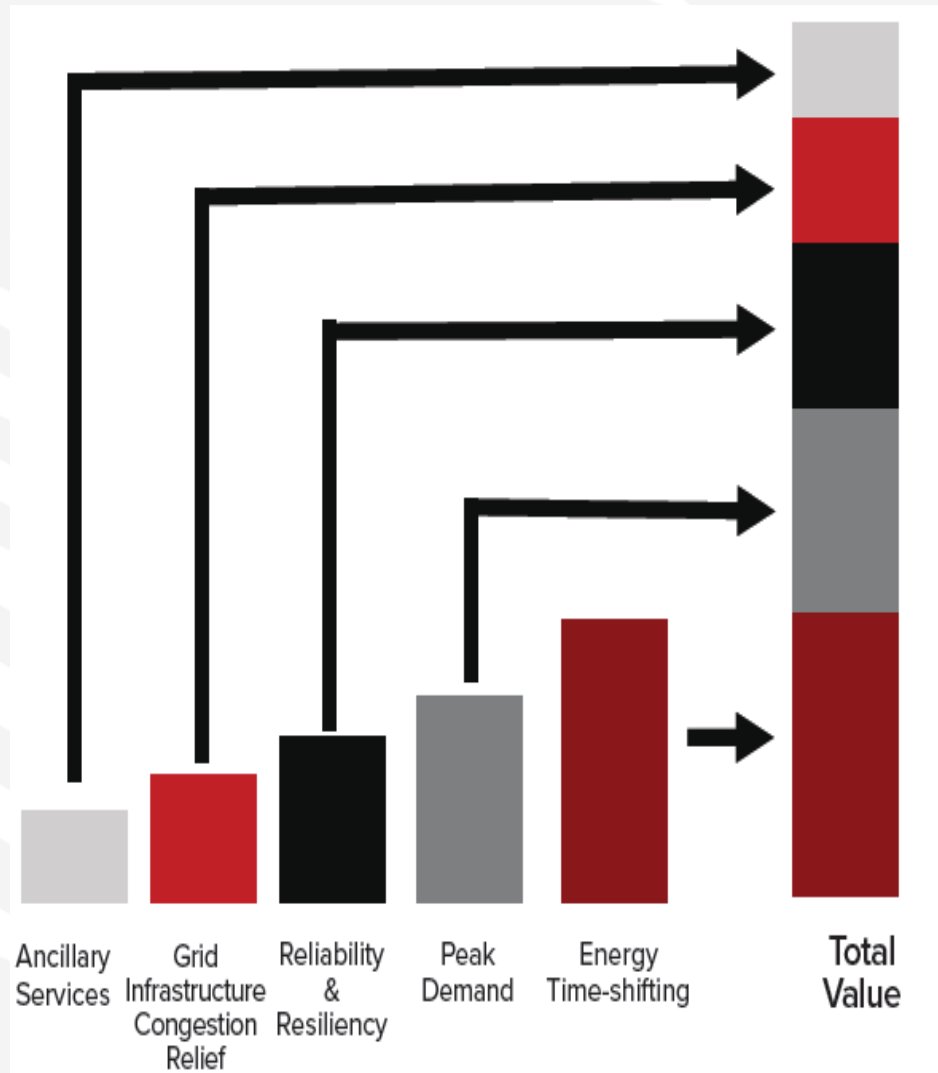

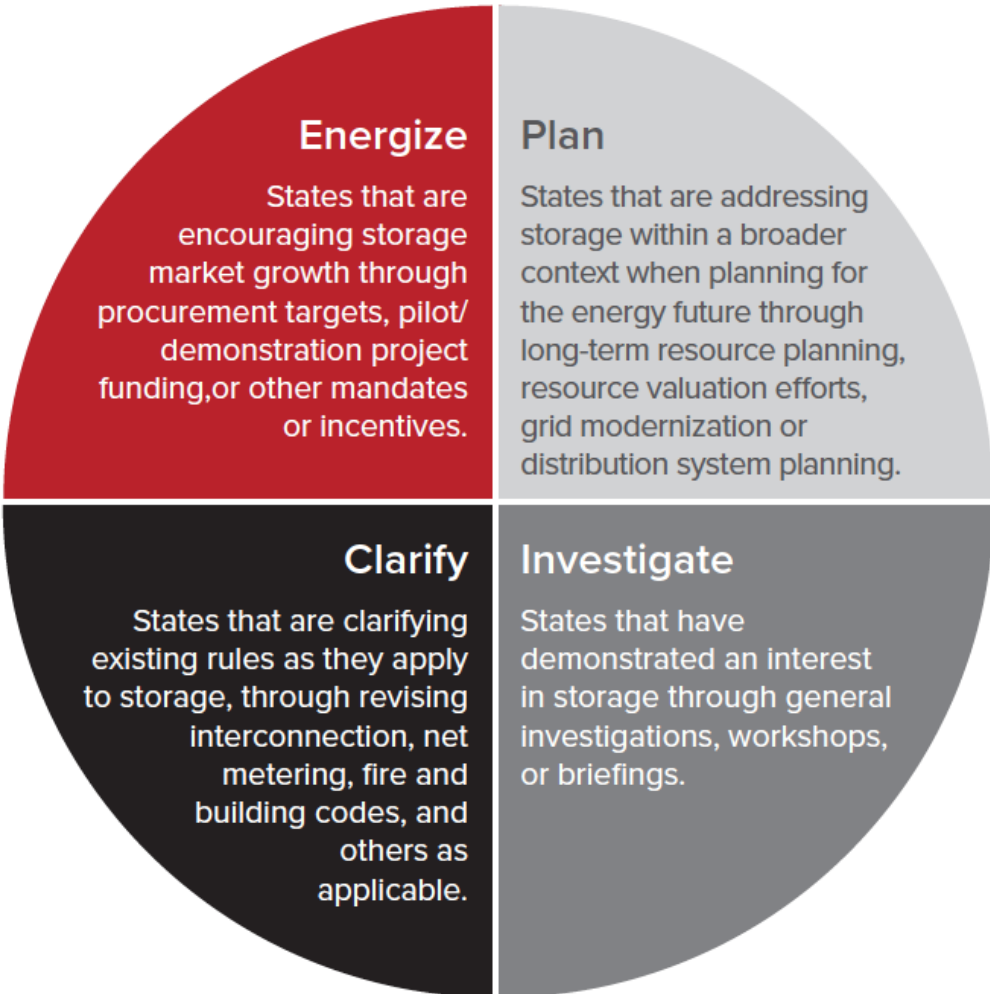

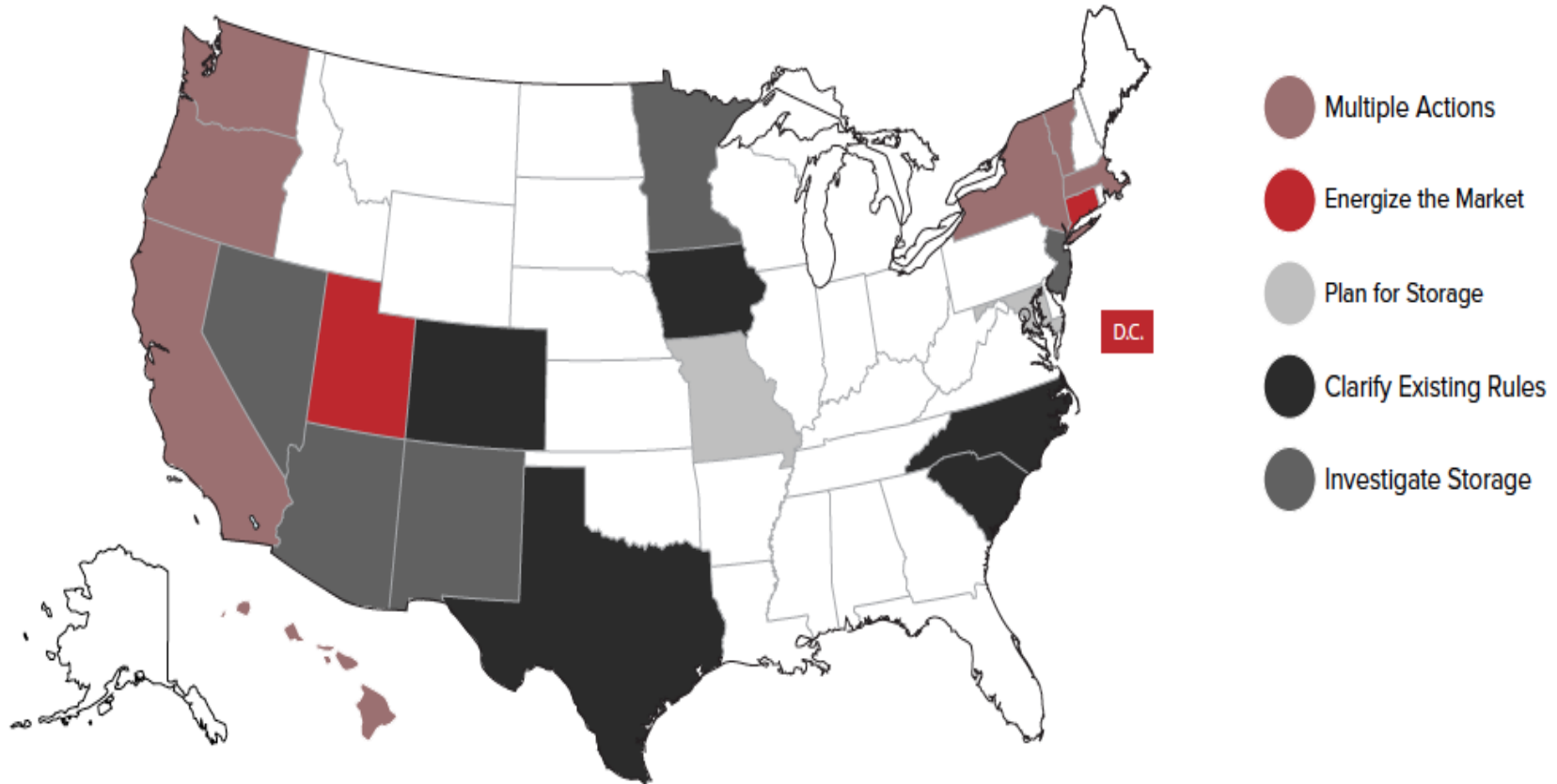
ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLE OF ENERGY STORAGE "VALUE STACKING" CONCEPT
